ITINERARY

Day 1 Thursday, October 1, 2026

Depart to Europe overnight on scheduled air service from MSP. Enjoy meals, beverages and inflight entertainment.

Day 2 Friday, October 2, 2026 <u>Arrival Europe | Prague</u> Morning arrival in Europe where you connect to Prague. On arrival in Prague, meet your local European tour manager who will be with you throughout the tour. Sightseeing in Prague begins in the Old Town. See the Jan Hus Square, Tyne Church, Astronomical Clock, Estates Theatre and the Charles Bridge. Check into the hotel and enjoy a welcome dinner. Meals: D

Day 3 Saturday, October 3, 2026

After breakfast at the hotel, sightseeing of Prague continues today with a trip to the Prague Castle high above the city. See the imposing Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral and then continue into the Old Town. Prague was home to composers Smetena and Dvořák. After dinner on your own, attend an evening concert by one of Prague's professional orchestras.

Day 4 Sunday, October 4, 2026 Kutna Hora | Prague Make an excursion out of Prague to the village of Kutna Hora. It's known for the Gothic St. Barbara's Church with medieval frescoes and flying buttresses. Also notable is Sedlec Ossuary, a PRE TOUR ZURICH EXTENSION chapel adorned with human bones. Return to Prague in the afternoon with some free-time to explore the Old Town. Our visit to Prague concludes this evening with a dinner cruise on the VItava River with all of its beautiful illuminated monuments. B/D

Day 5 Mon., October 5, 2026 Prague | Český Krumlov | Vienna Load the motor coach and depart for Vienna. En route, stop in the charming Bohemian village of Český Krumlov with time to explore and get lunch. Continue to Vienna. On arrival, see the Ring Strasse, State Opera House, Imperial Palace, State Apartments, National Library and the Hofburg Chapel. Check into the hotel and have the evening free for dinner.

Day 6 Tuesday, October 6, 2026

Vienna

Travel outside of the city-center for a morning guided tour of Schönbrunn Palace, once the summer residence of the Hapsburgs. Return to Vienna for lunch and have the afternoon free for exploring or shopping. Enjoy a group dinner before tonight's concert by one of Vienna's professional orchestras. B/D

Day 7 Wednesday, October 7, 2026 Eisenstadt | Vienna Travel to the Esterházy Palace in Eisenstadt today. It is one of the most beautiful baroque palaces in Austria and presents a fascinating view of life at the court of the Princes Esterházy. The Baroque Haydnsaal is the jewel of the palace. Its unique acoustics inspired the composer Joseph Haydn, who served the Esterházy princes for over forty years. Enjoy a traditional Heurigen dinner at Mayer am Pfarrplatz Heuriger. Beethoven once had a house here used for composition. B/D

Day 8 Thursday, October 8, 2026 Vienna | Budapest Check out of the hotel and travel to Budapest today. On arrival, a guided sightseeing tour of Budapest takes you to Parliament, Hero's Square, Thermal Baths, and St. Stephen's Basilica. After lunch, cross the Danube and drive to the Royal Castle on the Buda side of the river. Here we see the Fishermen's Bastion and the Matthias Church with spectacular views over the city. Check into the hotel and enjoy a group dinner.

Depart USA Day 9 Friday, October 9, 2026

Szentendre | Budapest

Travel out of Budapest today along the Danube River to Inflight Szentendre, a town north of the capital, Budapest. It's known for its baroque architecture, churches, colorful houses and narrow, cobbled streets. The main square, Fő Tér, and the alleyways around it are lined with art galleries, museums and shops. Return to Budapest where you can get dinner on your own on Váci utca, one of the main pedestrian thoroughfares and perhaps the most famous street of central Budapest. Conclude your day by attending a concert by one of the many professional orchestras in Budapest.

Prague Day 10 Saturday, October 10, 2026

Budapest

Enjoy a day for independent exploration of Budapest. Do some final souvenir shopping. Conclude your stay with a fun farewell dinner at Borkatakomba Étterem. Enjoy Hungarian food and dance as your tour comes to a close.

Day 2 Tuesday, September 29, 2026 Arrival Europe | Zurich Morning arrival in Europe where you connect to Zurich. On arrival, meet your local European tour manager who will be with you throughout the extension program. Begin your sightseeing with an orientation tour of Zurich. See the Grossmünster, Fraumunster and visit the Old Town. Enjoy a walk along the lakeside promenade around Lake Zurich. Check-in at the hotel and enjoy a welcome dinner. Inflight/D

Day 3 Wednesday, September 30, 2026

After breakfast at the hotel, you'll take an excursion out of Zurich to explore the natural beauty of the nearby Rhine Falls. With your tour manager, board a train and travel the short distance to Neuhausen am Rheinfall where you board a boat for the best view of the falls. After lunch on your own, return to Zurich with time to relax or explore independently in the afternoon. In the evening, enjoy a group dinner and a Q and A with Mankato native, Peter McGuire, who performs with the Tonhalle-Orchester Zürich. B/D

Day 4 Thursday, October 1, 2026

Today you'll take a day-trip to charming Lucerne. Travel by train through some of the most beautiful landscapes in all of Europe. On arrival, take a short walking tour of the historic old town, waterfront and over the famous Chapel Bridge. Have time on your own to have lunch and explore. Return to Zurich later in the afternoon with time for dinner on your own and a concert as the culmination to your experience in Switzerland.

Day 5 Friday, October 2, 2026

Zurich | Prague

Early morning hotel check out and transfer to the Zurich airport. Depart on your nonstop flight on Swiss International from Zurich to Prague. With a morning arrival, you'll meet the rest of the group in the arrivals hall. Continue the itinerary as outlined for the main tour. B/Inflight
